Creative Arts: Fostering imagination through art, music, and role-play.

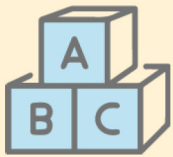

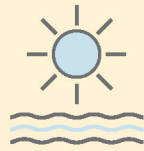

Self-directed learning with Montessori materials.



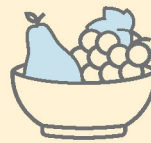
